#### **Head Teacher's report:**

- Thanks to all who donated to the Harvest food collection. The Clydesdale Food Bank have written a letter to thank you all for your generosity.
- P7 are currently in Lockerbie and so far have had a fantastic time.
- This week the nursery have offered parents the opportunity to attend an ante pre-school talk and a pre-school talk. Both events offer an opportunity for parents to find out more about what is happening in nursery and to ask questions.
- We are delighted to be having an author visit tomorrow. Christopher Duke is coming to speak to the children about 'Lucy's Blue Day' which highlights the different emotions Lucy has. This fits well with our EmotionWorks programme and we are looking forward to welcoming Christopher.

I have collated the results of both the parental and the pupil questionnaires which we will now look at. ### **Financial Report:**

### **Halloween Disco:**

### **Gin Night:**

At the last meeting we looked at the possibility of Gin tasting event followed by a game's night at the bowling club. We made initial contact with the Gin provider and the bowling club. The bowling club gave 2 dates available in the November but requested a letter to be presented to their committee. Unfortunately, by the time the Gin Company got in touch we had past the deadline. We will have to look at this again in the new year.

### **Fundraising ideas for coming year:**

Christmas fun day, as previously discussed the plan was that on the 6<sup>th</sup> Dec 19, we would have a fun day for the children including tombola and a sponsored walk etc. However, in light of the recent survey "cost of the school day" it was highlighted that some children did mention that it cost money to have a fun day at school.

A few things were decided to make the day more inclusive of all children.

On the weeks running up to the Nativity the children will be able to guess the amount of sweets in a jar, guess name or DOB of cuddly toy and also buy raffle tickets for a kid hamper.

All Children will then participate in the sponsored walk where the Parent council will provide every child with a Santa hat.

P Easton will put out a request for jars full of sweets n treats on the school app, these will be wrapped up and sold at the Nativity.

### **Other Business:**

Was raised about the cost not the quality of the school photographer (TEMPEST). Parents provided 2 photos of each of their children and if they have more than one child at the school, they usually have a group photo too. Tempest as a company can be really expensive but you are unable to do a combination of photos within one of the cheaper packages. This also adds to the cost of the school day as most parents will buy the school photo regardless.

P Easton said that this is something that will be looked into and we can see if we could get a cheaper provider but still have the same quality of photo, or see if tempest could do a cheaper combo deal.
