Nursery Enrolment



If you know of anyone who has a child who should be enrolled for starting nursery during the 2018-2019 session please ask them to phone the office and make an appointment to complete the relevant paperwork.

There are three intakes a year and children are eligible for a funded place in the intake following their third birthday:

- * Intake 1: August-December. Children who are 3 years old before 31 August
- * Intake 2: January-March. Children who are 3 years old before 31 December
- * Intake 3: March-June. Children who are 3 years old before the last day of February

Applications for next session must be completed before 30th April 2018.
