We will shortly be seeking your views on how we should spend a portion of our Pupil Equity Fund this year. We have £1715 allocated to this. The consultation will start with the children and we will share their ideas with you and give you the opportunity to vote for how you think the money should be spent. This budget is allocated to the school each year to allow us to minimise the detrimental impact poverty can have on a child's learning and ensure all children have equal opportunity of a variety of experiences.

Standards and Quality Report and School Improvement Plan

Following the results of our end of year consultations, we have devised our Standards and Quality Report, this details our achievements from last year, and an Improvement Plan which highlights our priorities for this year.
