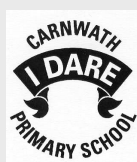

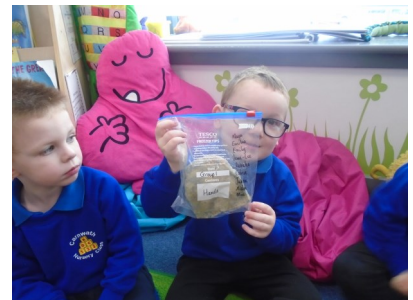
Den building
